Forty-three states have seen steady enrollment declines from 2013 thru 2018. The previous 31 years, enrollment declined for only 6 of those years (1980 to 2011). NY State is among 34 states that is above the national average in enrollment declines.

Buffalo State Undergraduate Enrollment Trend by School

From 2015 School of Education UG enrollment increased by 26% and 9% from last year. This year, the other 3 schools decreased from 4% in Art and Humanities to 8% in the School of Professions and School of Natural and Social Sciences.

Buffalo State Graduate Enrollment Trend by Student Type

Decrease of 13 percent in new graduate students and an increase of 3 percent in continuing and returning students

Buffalo State Graduate Enrollment Trend by Schools

School of Education increased 11 percent from previous fall and 30 percent from fall 2016.
