Counseling Center

Bring students to the counseling center if:

- Thoughts of suicide without a plan, timeframe or intent (“maybe everyone would be better off without me”, “I don’t know if I can do this anymore”)
 - Unexplained anger/irritability
 - Unusual behavior (talking to themselves, saying nonsensical statements)
